Opening Business

Steve called the meeting to order at 7:12 PM and a quorum was established.

Steve read the committee meeting rules.

The April 2019 Minutes and May 2019 Minutes were approved as amended

There were no comments from the Co-Chairs.

Public Comment

Bonnie gave a report on the LA Region Water Board meeting that occurred in May and stated the Stormwater Expert panel showed test results that included metals, alpha with 57 violations. She also stated the nuclear accident in 1958 released 300,000 times the background of radioactive materials. In the Voices of Malibu newsletter, they said that testing revealed nuclides. She said that the DTSC RICO Report said that Boeing does not have TCE information and that it is in the groundwater moving off site. She said the same for perchlorate. She also said the next drinking water meeting in Simi would be held on July 11.

Christina Walsh accused Steve and Char of insulting her in other meetings and said they made inappropriate remarks.

New Business

Alec raised the issue of when does the SSFL cleanup begin. In reviewing the DTSC March Activity Report, he found that DTSC has received many data summary reports from the RP's since 2016 and the majority have not been approved. A DOE permit request submitted in 2016 has not been approved and there has been no response to public comments regarding the DSTC draft EIR and Program management report that were submitted in 2017. Alec suspected that the EIR will not be issued this year.

Myrl raised the points that the Committee should be communicating with the state and local politicians. He also suggested that allergies are widespread and should be discussed at our next meeting.

Bonnie spoke asking for the Committee take a position opposing Scouts going to the SSFL, and opposing Sky Valley Volunteers speaking at schools inviting others to visit the SSFL

Brad suggested that we contact the Department of Urban Forestry to speak at one of our meetings.

Old Business

No items were discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 PM.
